

How to screen share during a Webex Meeting with both in-person and extended-campus learners.

### **Solutions if you only have one device**

#### **Solution 1**

Have your in-class students also use Webex Meetings so that everything is seen via Webex without the need to project anything on a wall for the in-class students. You'll want the in-class students to mute their speakers.

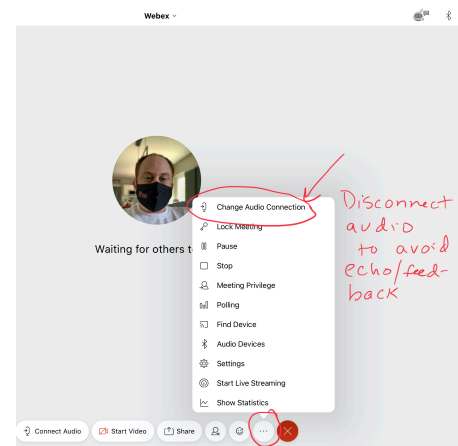
#### **Solution 2**

If you must AirPlay from the same device you are using Webex from, try it without Chrome open. Completely QUIT out of Chrome before you start Webex and AirPlay, and maybe it will work.

### **Solutions if you have two devices (like a MacBook Air and an iPad)**

#### **Solution A**

Log in to Webex on both devices. AirPlay from the MacBook with the audio on. On the iPad, turn the audio connection off to avoid an echo and feedback (see the picture).



#### **Solution B**

Use the iPad to do the AirPlay projection, use the MacBook to join the Webex Meeting and point the MacBook at the projected image on the wall so that everyone in Webex can see the projected image via the MacBook's camera.
